

CCHS Family Network and International Research Conference: Research Fair Proposals

Research Fair participants will share a conference-provided joint space on Thursday, June 21, 2018 in the afternoon, with the primary goal of sharing information with potential participants and recruitment. Data collection, with the exception of very targeted studies, will not be possible at the Fair given space constraints and consideration for privacy/data collection environment. Any and all recruitment done at the conference (a) must be IRB approved and the IRB approved recruitment document must be on file with Conference Review Committee, (b) is limited to the time and location assigned by Conference Review Committee, and (c) the financial burden of recruitment (e.g. time, location/space, and personnel) will solely be at the cost of the investigator. Invitation to present at the Fair is not an endorsement of the study or investigators by the Conference or Network. Proposals will be evaluated by the 2018 CCHS Conference Review Committee with notification of decisions made by April 16, 2018.
